## **GRA TREASURER REPORT YE MARCH 2023**

There have been a few changes as far as the financials are concerned in the 2022/2023 financial year:-

- 1) We now have our accounts fully integrated onto MYOB with all supplier invoices uploaded and recorded in the system, we no longer need to keep paper copies.
  - As a result of the integration there were some minor reallocations made in the general ledger between expenses cleaning invoices being one such example as they were not correctly allocated between the two halls, the OSB was overstated;
  - The bank reconciliations are also now done through MYOB and balance to the bank statement. There was a small adjustment made to the bank account to get it to balance to ASB.
- 2) The Stripe payment system was updated with all the required Office Bearer identity documents verified, we have also activated the two-step authentication as a safeguard. All hall bookings are paid upon booking through Stripe.
- 3) The GST returns will be done by the Treasurer through MYOB now at a saving of approximately \$500 accountant's costs per year.
- 4) Income and Expenditure:
  - a. Income is up from 2022 with the main hall having a net increase of \$9412 and the OSB \$2503. Michelle, our hall manager does an outstanding job and has mentioned that we now get a lot more casual bookings due to lockdown being over, we are also very lucky to have many regulars use the hall.
  - b. We managed to secure a rates rebate for this year but they are harder to attain as the Auckland Council tightens their belts.
  - c. The settlement of the land that was sold behind the hall was done the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2023 and the income reflected in the Income Statement.
  - d. Repairs and Maintenance costs were undertaken at both halls as follows:
    - i. Main Hall

New signage has been installed at a cost of about \$2k, some of that cost extends into the new financial year due to delays.

Some plumbing repairs were also undertaken

ii. OSB

Window repairs – the windows were replaced with toughened glass before the painting was done.

- e. Cleaning costs are up but they go hand in hand with increased usage.
- f. There was a significant increase in water costs, a water leak was discovered and repaired in April.

I would like to thank Ken for his support during my first year as Treasurer and also a big thank you to Tricia for being second release in ASB on the many payments I load. To Michelle, thank you for all the hard work on the hall invoicing, I know it is a lot of admin and you do an outstanding job.

I have enjoyed my time as the GRA Treasurer and I hope my contribution to automating the accounts will make it easier for the next person taking on the role. Due to a changes in my work responsibilities and time commitments, I unfortunately won't be able to stand for the next term. If anyone has a few spare hours each week and feels they would like to be part of the team then please come and chat to myself or Ken afterwards.
