Re - Dangerious Footpaths in Greenhithe Project

This submission is a request to have repair work carried out on 108 broken footpaths concidered to be dangerious, some known to have caused accidents.

The Committee has compiled this list based on the criteria that the defective path must have a trip of 15mm or greater or be completely crazed or missing all together.

They have excluded;

- 1. The many hundreds of cracks that are concided 'cosmetic' fixes.
- 2. Walking paths that are the juristiction of the Council Parks Dept.
- Rame Road from 71 > as this is part of an active redevelopment program with Auckland Transport and Auckland Council from a Local Board funding allocation.
- 4. Any reference to the nine roads in Greenhithe with no footpaths at all.

The 25 issues that are accessed as Critical * are marked in Red. Watercare issues are marked in blue and those that are clearly contractor damage are marked in Orange.

In carrying out this exercise, walking or riding every street, it was recognised that Greenhithe has many kilometers of very good footpaths, particually those constructed in the last 20 years. Most of the attached defects are in older established areas.

Greenhithe has histroically been a much neglected backwater of the North Shore where footpath repair has appeared to have been a low priority. It is plagued with more than normal ground water seapage and tree roots causing many of these issues.

There is community wide concern about the safety of our footpaths which is justified following this research. This community, which is now a large rates contributor to AucklandCouncil, would be most grateful if we could progressively have our 'danger' spots

repatriated over the next year or two. Certianly the extreme danger spots addressed with some haste.

We are most happy to meet Auckland Transport officers along with Councillors and Local Board representitives to inspect these trouble spots.

We look forward to your early, post C19, response.


